



THE COASTAL FORCES MONUMENT AT THE DESIGN STAGE



The figures will be life sized bronzes. The boat and wave structures will be composites with bronze resin. The men will stand almost four metres above the ground and the overall footprint is about 20m². They are looking towards the British Military Powerboat Collection and a third figure, a WRNS signaller, who will be stood several yards away against Boathouse No4, replying to their message. The waves incorporate some seating and a series of carved images depicting Coastal Forces and RNVR scenes from both World Wars. This is the final maquette, from which construction can commence.
